WATER

WATER

JOBS

AWS has hired 1,056 full-time employees as of July 2026. At completion, AWS will employ more than 1,200 workers, making it one of St. Joseph County's largest employers.

TAXES

AWS is not paying taxes and residents are paying for all utility upgrades.



TAXES

AWS pays taxes from day one. Over the incentive period, AWS is projected to pay more than \$1 billion in local taxes.

In a few years AWS will abandon the buildings, leaving behind vacant structures and blight.
